The time commitment we prefer is weekly for about an hour, but we appreciate any time our volunteers can provide to our patients. We also utilize volunteers to make weekly phone calls to our home bound patients. We have special programs for our veterans' patients, and utilize volunteers to make "thinking of you" cards, blankets, walker bags, etc. We also have music therapist volunteers, art therapist, and a hairstylist. Volunteers undergo training and must complete 2 step TB, background check, and drug test.
