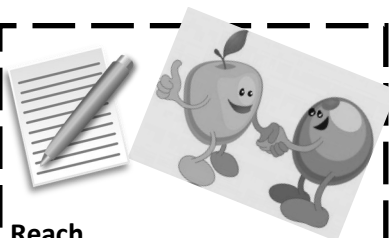

**Secretary's Report:** Minutes of the spring 2024 General Membership Meeting were published in the Communique. Phil Loht moved to accept the minutes and Don Rineer seconded. The motion passed.

**Treasurer's Report:** The following is the checking account balance for the period September 1, 2024 to October 1, 2024. Opening Balance of &6,253.23. income of \$1,660.10 and expenses of \$2,218.81 resulting in a balance of \$5,694.52.
